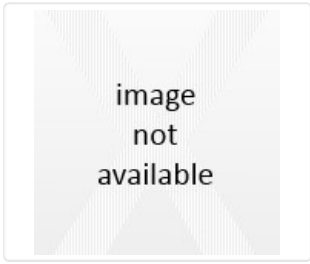

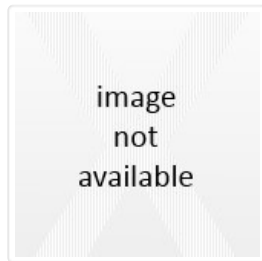


Harvey Davies and Mrs. H. Davies planting an oak tree in front of the Government Building (now the Central Park Building). Mr. Windt is also in attendance.

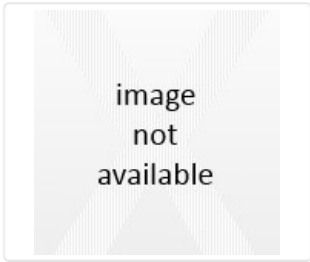

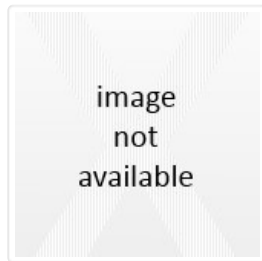


Parade in honour of the coronation of King George II. Photo taken down Main Street from the Central Park Building toward the train station.

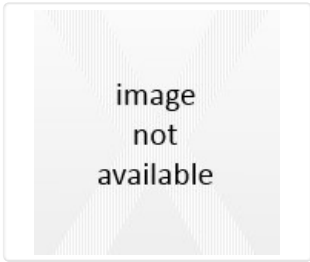

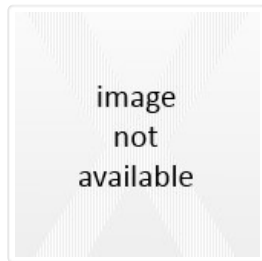


Parade in honour of the coronation of King George II. Photo taken down Main Street from the Central Park Building toward the train station.

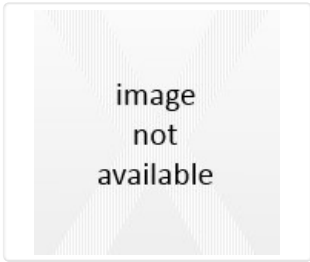

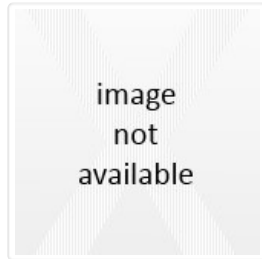


Band playing in front of the Government Building (now the Central Park Building) at the coronation of King George II.

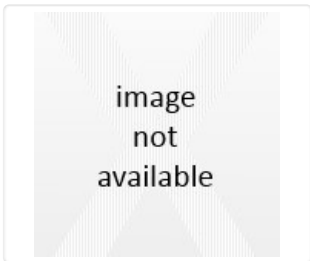

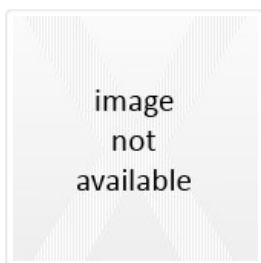


The old Legion building in Smithers, BC, built after World War I.

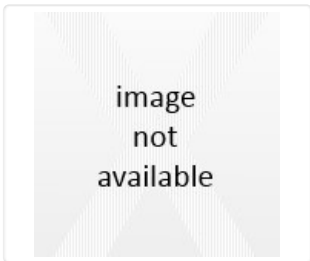

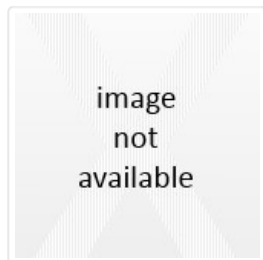

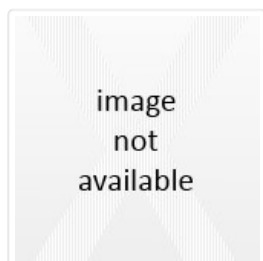


Interior of the Old Town Hall (where the Federal Building now stands) decorated for a celebration with many British flags. This might be in honour of the coronation of King George II.

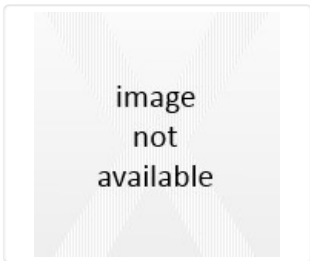

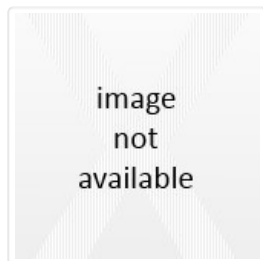


Retirement dinner for Happy Turner. Fred Fowler and Joe McDonald are pictured in the gathering.

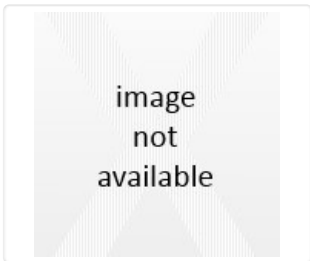

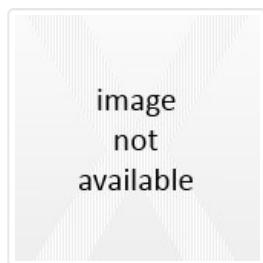


Portrait of Phyllis and Percy Davidson (parents of Jim Davidson).
