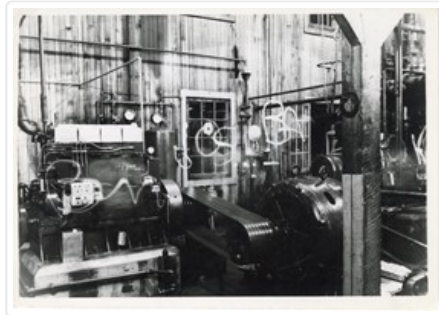


Interior of Columbia Power
